#1... YOU NEED A PASSPORT!

In order to find the best prices with the least amount of problems, I have arranged to have our travel agent work with you to make things easier.

Travel by air to the Sault has some special considerations which, if not taken good care of, can leave you stranded. The reason is that the aircrafts flying from the Sault to Detroit (going the US way) or to Toronto (going the Canadian route) are small turbo props.

The alternative is to rent a car in Detroit and drive the last 6 hours (8 hrs from Toronto). You would save a significant amount of dollars doing this, especially if you travel with a group that can share car rental costs and driving. The flight from Detroit or Toronto to the Sault is at least \$200.00. Multiply this by the number of people in your group, and the saving is big. 4 lane hwy all the way

Because folks are literally traveling from all corners of the world, making group travel arrangements are not easy, but I am sure that your price will be very competitive, and to save the hassle of working out the details of this particular flight will save you a HUGE headache.

Destinations in the US. Kincheloe Airport (45 min), Pellston Airport (1:30 hr), Detroit (6 hr)
Canadian route: Sault Ste Marie, ON. (Five min from my home on Airport Road.)
