GM Baubil and I first met in Seoul, Korea. We hit it off right away, and we had a great time exploring Korean culture together.

FOUNDER OF HOSHINKIDO

GM Baubil started Martial arts in 1959 with shotokan karaté and judo, Today he is 59 years old, with nearly 50 years of practice.

GM Baubil was an former martial arts instructor for French police association, and he was later sent to central Africa (5 years) as martial arts instructor for the police forces and presidential bodyguards in Gabon, Cameroon, Zaire, Congo and central Africa.

He officially introduced taekwondo in Cameroon, Africa, and he was the national Trainer and technical council for the Zaire Karate Federation (taekwondo department).

In 1983, GM Baubil introduced Qwankido (vietnamese kung-fu kempo) to Brasil, and he was

Brasil's Regional Director for taekwondo and Hapkido.

GM Baubil was assistant to Grandmaster Sang min, CHO, who officially introduced taekwondo in Brasil, as well as assistant to Bum moo kwan hapkido Founder, Grandmaster Yun sik kim, a former Korean marine corps chief instructor as well as former student of Grandmaster Ji han jae.

The hoshinkido method was born in 1992 in Montreal, Canada with the foundation of the Canadian Hoshinkido hapkido association. The international Hoshinkido hapkido Federation now has representatives in more than 15 countries.

We are extremely proud that GM Baubil has agreed to share his vast amount of knowledge with us.

In addition to being the Grand Master of Hoshinkido, holding a 9th dahn in Hap Ki Do, as well as a 5th dahn Master level in Tae Kwon Do, Grand Master Baubil also holds a 4th dan in Shotokan and a 3rd dan in Judo. In 1970, GM Baubil trains in

Chung Do Kwan Tae Kwon Do and Hap Ki do under GTM Lee, Kwan Young, and in 1973 he became the president/founder of the Taekwondo Institute of Paris, France. Truly an impressive amount of knowledge he will share with us.
